SPECIFIC TASKS

- 1) Assist with visitors, queries and advising of park rules/regulations and enforcing these when necessary.
- 2) Direct parking and control traffic within the Park's designated parking zone.
- 3) Patrol roads, tracks and important forested areas, observe and report illegal sand extraction, grazing, tree cutting, community access and wild dogs.
- 4) Meet and greet visitors to the Visitor Information Centre, act as cashier, collection of admission fees, selling of merchandise, stock taking and the reconciling Park Income Book.
- 5) Ensure the protection of native flora and fauna found within the park boundary as well as assist with related research projects.
- 6) Ensure Park, its visitor facilities and equipment are clean and properly maintained.
- 7) Assist with the development of visitor facilities, including the creation of new tracks and walkways.
- 8) Assist in the monitoring of park permits issued to researchers, film makers and photographers to the park.
- 9) Assist with the Park's rehabilitation programmes including the collection of native seeds, seedlings and maintenance of the site nursery.
- 10) Support nearby and local communities through the Park's educational programmes and assist them in developing environmentally sustainable practices.
- 11) Assist with the protection and recording of the archaeological sites at the SSDNP.
- 12) Assist in any emergency situations, including emergency calls to appropriate agencies – First Aid, Search and Rescue and or NFA.
